1. Moet & Chandon Brut 1 £55.95
FRANCE
Still the best selling Non-Vintage Champagne in the UK, this classic blend boasts notes of green apple and citrus fruits.

2. House Champagne Non-Vintage 1 £31.50
FRANCE

Sparkling Wine

3. Prosecco Serenello Extra Dry 1 £22.50
ITALY 20cl Bottle £6.00
The delicious aromas of apple and pear melt into a smooth and fresh wine on the palate.

4. Spumante Serenello Rose 1 £22.50
ITALY 20cl Bottle £6.00
A lovely rose pink colour, followed by a bright and aromatic nose of petals and fresh strawberries. The palate is clean, crisp and vibrant on the finish.

6. Monterey Bay Zinfandel Rosé 5 £16.95
USA 175ml Glass £4.60
250ml Glass £5.80
Quite the most delicious wine, a lively mix of watermelon and cherry with a delectable sweetness.

7. Chemin de Provence Rosé 2 £22.50
France
Red fruits like raspberries and strawberries on the nose initially then more exotic fruits like guava in the background. The palate is fresh and clean, emphasising ripe strawberries and perfectly balanced acidity.



White Wine

8. House White 2 £14.95
175ml Glass £4.00

9. Pinot Grigio Primi Soli 2 £15.50
Italy
Dry, crisp and fruity with a wonderful hint of lemon.

10. Via Alta Chardonnay £16.95
Chile
A fresh, tropical fruit flavoured Chardonnay. This wine displays lots of refreshing citrus acidity to give a great lift on the palate.

11. Turtle Bay Sauvignon Blanc 1 £19.50
New Zealand 175ml Glass £5.20
250ml Glass £6.60
This wine is fresh and vibrant with passion fruit, gooseberry and some melon characters. It has a balanced richness of fruit with a floral note through the palate, with intense depth of flavour and a crisp finish.

12. Parlez - vous? 'Picpoul de Pinet' 2 £19.50
France 175ml Glass £5.20
250ml Glass £6.60
Crystal clear with green highlights. A soft, delicate nose, with pleasant hints of acacia and hawthorn blossom. Delicate and fresh in the mouth it has an excellent balance of structure and acidity.

13. Chablis Victor Berard 1 £29.95
France
A classic bone dry white wine that has a full steely palate.

Red Wine

14. House Red Wine B £14.95
175ml Glass £4.00
250ml Glass £5.50

15. Inkosi Pinotage C £15.50
South Africa
Smooth ripe damson and a hint of vanilla followed by soft rounded tannins giving good length on the finish.

16. Studio 1 Shiraz Viognier C £19.50
Australia 175ml Glass £5.20
250ml Glass £6.60
Typical Australian blend of Shiraz and Viognier. Ripe and rich, with violet aromas and bramble fruit flavours.

17. Equino Malbec D £18.50
Argentina 175ml Glass £5.00
250ml Glass £6.50
A mix of plum, raspberry and blackberry, medium-bodied, yet soft and silky with seductive tannins. The purity of this wine is a natural acidity which complements the fruits in a great lengthy finish.

18. Faustino Rivero Joven D.O.Ca Rioja B £19.95
Spain 175ml Glass £5.30
250ml Glass £6.70
A bright wine with red berry aromas underscored by notes of liquorice

19. Cotes du Rhone Victor Berard C £22.50
France
Warm spicy wine that has a soft peppery taste coming from the Grenache and Syrah varieties.

20. Chateaufeuf du Pape Reserve des Argentiers E £39.95
France
Dark ruby in colour, with a complex bouquet of fruit, spices, thyme, rosemary and pepper. This is a full bodied red with notes of liquorice, leather and wild fruit delivering big mouth feel with silky tannins.
