OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18) A ball is out of bounds if it lies:

- On or beyond any boundary fence or hedge.
- On or beyond the white posts marking the edge of the track behind the green of holes 9 &18.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

- The following are designated as Immovable Obstructions:

 1. All artificially covered or edged pathways or tracks
 (e.g. shells, crushed granite, tarmac, plastic and
 rubble) are immovable obstructions. All other
 pathways and tracks are integral parts of the course.
- All posts and rails and course furniture.
 Concrete Posts marking Public Footpaths
- All parts of the automatic watering system.
 The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, and is within two-club lengths of the putting green, and within two-club lengths of the ball (e.g. fixed sprinkler heads).

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITION (Rule 16)

- Ground under repair is marked with continuous white lines, pig tails or hoops.
- In the general area, deep vehicle tracks and ruts are treated as ground under repair and free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1b.

No Play Zones

All newly turfed and seeded areas, with the exception of seeded divots, are No Play Zones from which free relief

PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

Penalty areas are defined by red or yellow stakes.
Unmarked ditches are to be treated as red penalty areas. The edge of the unmarked penalty area is where the

ground breaks down. The pond on holes 3 & 12 is a yellow penalty area.

STAKED OR SLEEVED TREES (Rule 16.1f)

Staked or sleeved trees are No Play Zones, and if a player's ball lies on or touches such a tree, or such a tree interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

All golfers are cautioned to take extra care on the golf and general to Catherine do that earne care on the golf course when negotiating foot bridges, uneven ground and penalty areas (formerly water hazards).
